<b>VINEYARD LOCATION</b>	Thau Lagoon basin, dried-up marsh of Marseillette, Herault Valley's mid-slope, slopes of the Orb Valley
<b>ELEVATION</b>	Approximately 300-400 meters above sea level
<b>SOIL TYPE</b>	Calcareous clay with rounded river stones; slightly salty, loamy clay
<b>FARMING PRACTICES</b>	 Sustainable Farming Practices
<b>AVERAGE VINE AGE</b>	5-30 years
<b>CASE PRODUCTION</b>	28,000 cases (12 bottles/case)
<b>YIELD</b>	70 hl/ha
